

Noble Beast Vaccine Requirements



For the safety of all the dogs and puppies (especially yours!) who attend any of our group Classes, Noble Beast Dog Training requires all dogs and puppies be properly vaccinated.

For Puppies 19 Weeks and Younger, we require the following **two** vaccinations:

1. **DISTEMPER VACCINE** - The *Distemper Vaccine* is a series of 3-4 vaccinations given 3-4 week apart normally starting when puppies are about 8 weeks old. ***Puppies must be current based on age only*** - meaning you do **NOT** need to wait for all 3 Distemper Vaccine boosters to be completed before attending class!
2. **BORDETELLA VACCINE** - The *Bordetella (Kennel Cough) Vaccine*: we either need to see proof of a current vaccination for **all puppies 8 weeks and older** OR we offer our owners the option of signing our Bordetella Waiver in lieu of the vaccine. Just ask us for a link to sign our Waiver if you choose to not have the vaccine done!

For Dogs 20 Weeks and Older, we require the following **three** vaccinations:

1. **DISTEMPER VACCINE** – All dogs 20 weeks and older must be current on the *Distemper Vaccine*.
2. **BORDETELLA VACCINE** - The *Bordetella (Kennel Cough) Vaccine*: we either need to see proof of a current vaccination for **all dogs 8 weeks and older** OR we offer our owners the option of signing our Bordetella Waiver in lieu of the vaccine. Just ask us for a link to sign our Waiver if you choose to not have the vaccine done!
3. **RABIES VACCINE** - All dogs 20 weeks and older must be current on the *Rabies Vaccine* as required by the State of Colorado.

We are happy to report we **DO ACCEPT** Bordetella Waivers, Titters, and/or Vet Vaccine Exemption Letters at all locations!

If your dog does not meet the above Vaccine Requirements, you will not be able to attend Class until the Requirements are met.

Please note: If your vaccines are handwritten, the stickers from the vaccine bottles **MUST** be present or we will not be able to accept them. The exception to the handwritten vaccine requirement would be if it comes from a veterinarian, breeder or rescue on official letterhead or with the organizations contact information (name, phone number and email or website).

**Please understand we follow the above vaccination guidelines with no exceptions.
This is for the safety and well-being for all the puppies and dogs, including yours!**
